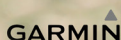

HOMELAND SECURITY

When it comes to finding prohibited fruit, vegetables, plants, and meat products from high-risk countries, the nose knows. A trained agriculture dog can scan a piece of luggage for smuggled or forgotten fruits in mere seconds. Understandably, it takes an officer much longer to open and visually inspect the same bag.

U.S. Customs & Border Protection (CBP) detector dogs are a key tool for screening passengers and cargo to prevent the introduction of harmful plant pests and foreign animal disease from entering the U.S.

Every year countless dogs and cats are lost due to lack of proper identification. Millions of dogs and cats, horses, livestock and birds now carry microchips. Wildlife and endangered species, reptiles and even fish are being studied and managed with the aid of this great technology.

Developed by veterinarians, the microchip is safe, permanent and takes only seconds to administer. The microchip is a tiny computer chip that has an identification number programmed into it. This microchip is encapsulated within biocompatible material. The whole device is small enough to fit into a hypodermic needle and can be simply injected under the skin of a pet where it will stay for the life of the animal. The tiny injectable “chip” contains a one-of-a-kind identification number and is recognized worldwide. A scanner is used to read the microchip through the skin of the animal. The animal feels nothing as the chip’s number quickly appears in the scanner’s viewing window. This provides a permanent positive identification that cannot be lost, altered or intentionally removed with the added security of an international database which operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. It is a safe, simple and inexpensive way to protect your pet against loss or theft.



STAYING COOL DURING HOT WEATHER AT THE BARK

We know you and your four-footed best buddy want to have the best of times at the Bark. So it's important to remember that dogs are not as good as people in getting rid of excess body heat. Dogs do not sweat like people do to cool off. They are able to shed a very small amount of body heat by panting and sweating through the pads of their paws. So it is important to watch your dog during the hot weather and keep him safe. Never, Ever, Leave Your Dog in the Car on a Hot Day. Cars heat up much quicker than you realize, even with the windows open. It's best to leave your dog at home on a hot day, when you do your errands. Heatstroke can be very damaging and a dog that has had it once can be prone to getting it again.

Some Symptoms of Heatstroke Are

Rapid or heavy breathing • Bright red tongue • Thick saliva • Vomiting
Legs, ears, hot to the touch • Bloody diarrhea • Unsteadiness • Hot, dry nose

Extreme Symptoms are glassy-eyed, gray lips

If you feel your dog has become overheated and possibly suffering from heatstroke you should do the following:

Gradually wet your dog using cool, not cold water.

Get him out of direct sunlight

Give your dog very small amounts of cool water to drink.

Get your dog to a veterinarian as soon as possible.

Dog Walking Depot

MAKE IT:

Get organized with this handy dog walking station. It holds your dog's leash and treats, and has a message board to leave a note for mom.

- 1 Remove the glass from a picture frame and trace around it onto a piece of colored paper.
- 2 Cut out along the line you just drew. Write your dog's name on the paper or decorate it with photos or stickers. Leave space in the middle for erasable notes.
- 3 Insert your decorated paper and the glass back into the picture frame. Attach hooks to hang your dog's leash and a pail for biscuits.

FINISHING TOUCHES: Use Velcro to attach a dry-erase marker to the picture frame. With the marker you can write notes right on the glass.

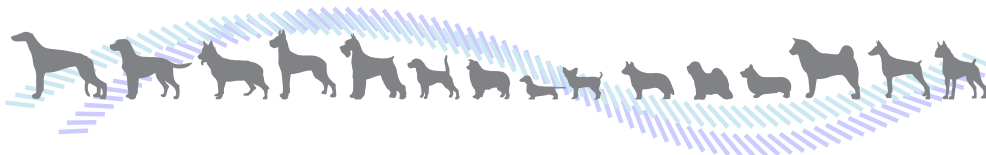

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TEST

The CGC Test is to demonstrate that the dog, as a companion of man, can be a respected member of the community, and can be trained and conditioned to always behave in the home, in public places, and in the presence of other dogs in a manner that will reflect credit on the dog. To qualify, a dog must pass each of the ten test categories listed below:

Accepting a Friendly Stranger, Sitting Politely for Petting, Appearance and Grooming, Out for a Walk (walking on loose leash), Walking Through a Crowd, Sit and Down on Command/Staying in Place, Coming when Called, Reaction to Another Dog, Reactions to Distractions, Supervised Separation
